## **Plum Cloutman**

Althuis Hofland Fine Arts is pleased to announce the opening of Space II (a second exhibition space within the gallery), with an inaugural exhibition by London and Norfolk-based painter and printmaker Plum Cloutman.

Cloutman's small works on paper and panel are drawn with pastels and watercolour pencil in an earthy and soft, muted palette that appears to belong to the English countryside. Her use of estranged perspective, and slightly manieristic figures turn seemingly ordinary scene's into a dreamy scape, slowly unfolding into a surrealist tableau of multiple little narratives.

*Plum Cloutman is a painter and printmaker whose work has been awarded the Catriona White Prize, the Lyon and Turnbull Prize, and was featured in the 2019 Royal Society of Arts New Contemporaries exhibition. She graduated in 2018 from Edinburgh College of Art.*
